

Managing Contractors

Legislation and case law lay down specific duties requiring employers, clients, or occupiers of premises to control contractors. Where the normal definition of construction work does not apply, the person in control is still legally required to implement systems and procedures such as those outlined in the HSE publication Managing Contractors and Joint Responsibility.
